

ROYAL ENFIELD Entry No. 295.

Entrant; IVOR MUTTON, Redditch.

1926 Royal Enfield Model 352 catalogued as a Super Sports / Racing Model fitted with 344cc OHV J.A.P. Racing Engine type SOR/T No. 59278.

First registered 21st., April 1926, registration number TU 2005, by a Mr. Grosvener of Crewe, Cheshire. In July 1930 passed to a Mr. James of Willaston, Nantwich, Cheshire, and then in November 1931 to a Mr. Cole of Harrow, Middlesex.

Mr. Cole rode the machine until the latter part of 1932 when it was laid up in his garage where it remained for fifty years until acquired by the entrant in March 1982, since when it has been rebuilt to it's original condition and specification.

It is believed that this machine was raced by the first owner in sand races on the Lancashire coast and the entrant would be pleased to receive any information.

It was on a works edition of the Royal Enfield Model 352 that Stanley Woods rode in the 1925 Junior T.T. Races in the Isle of Man.
