10€

(For all the participants-payment on site at the secretary vancash only)

CHRISSA CAMPSITE ADMISSION FEE 15€ (FOR 3 DAYS) OR 8€ DAILY

(This applies to all non-campsite & rooms residents (rally participants who stay elsewhere) and covers use of all the camping facilities & the pool)

- Tickets for **DELPHI** archaeological site and museum will be bought onsite and the general admission fee is 20€
- Osios Loukas monastery and museum entrance is free for Greek citizens and for international citizens the admission fee is 10€.
- At the Saturday's dinner to the campsite you must be 15 min earlier (19:15) to reserve seats
- At the rides you must be at the meeting point 15' earlier and have enough petrol for them. The nearest petrol station (BP) is in Delphi (5,7 miles/8,7 km one way/10' riding) which is open from 7am to 9pm.
- The rides will be held by groups. Participants must always follow the leader marshal and they must inform if they need to leave the group



Day 1- Friday 30th of May

10:00 Pre Rally Ride to Drosohori village

(30 miles/48,3 km roundtrip) *You must be 15' earlier at the campsite's meeting point-see the map. For the early travelers who will come to the campsite from Thursday we organized for you an extra ride to Drosohori village.Amazing short mountain route between olive groves and pure nature. At the return we will stop to Elaionas village for a refreshment to a small coffee shop.The return will be around 12:30 at the campsite.

13:30: Start of the rally, arrivals, registrations

17:30 We proudly announce you the first rally presentation: **Following the silk road!** REOC Greek member Arman Daniel travelled from Athens, Greece to Iran via Turkey, Georgia &Armenia with a Royal Enfield Meteor 350.A hard journey of 12.000 kilometers, on a trip lasting less than a month including the return trip!His experiences will be described will all the details. *Duration 1h- at the campsite area


19:30 Dinner to taverna "Bassanos" to Chrisso village with live Greek music which is very close from the campsite.

Tickets will be bought onsite.

12:00 Ride from Delphi museum to Osios Loukas monastery (55,9 miles/90 km roundtrip)

A 1,000-year-old monastery, a UNESCO protected monument, welcomes a multitude of visitors daily who are subjected to its unparalleled aesthetics and undeniable architectural value. We will visit the monastery and have a quick coffee/refreshment there.

14:00 Lunch to the local tavern 'Dimos' (only 7 minutes from the monastery).


You must book your seat at the tavern in advance plus the main plate you choose! (Middle of May all participants will receive an online form to choose their main plate of every meal)



An old Grecian custom from 1955! REVS magazine -The winter edition (The official Royal Enfield magazine for dealers of the era)

"Athens 1955

On New Year's Eve there takes place in Greece the countrywide custom of giving presents to policemen on point duty. These pictures show the Enfield bicycle which was one of a number of presents from drivers of this most frequented crossing in the city. Permission was given for the bicycle to remain in this public spot all day, where it gained a great amount amount of publicity, as it is estimated that 300.000 people use this crossing daily
